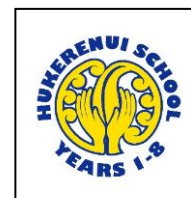


Hukerenui School Agricultural Day

28 October 2017



This year's AG day is on **Saturday, 28 October 2017**.

This is one of the most important days of the year for the school and community. A fantastic day on our school and community calendar, where we celebrate the rural character of our school. The strength of our Ag Day is one that is envied by other schools in our district.

Judging will start at 9.30am, but feel free to come earlier and soak up the atmosphere! Children will be competing with calves, lambs, goats and pets, as well as displaying all their indoor exhibitions.

On this day children demonstrate how well they have cared for a calf, goat or lamb over the past few months. All children are encouraged to rear an animal; there are plenty of cups, ribbons and rosettes for everyone.

We realise it can be expensive for a non farming family to have a pet; however, it is a great opportunity for children to learn the importance of animal care. There is a Pet section with prizes for those children who cannot raise an animal listed above. The pet section does not require pre registration; you can enter on the day. Bring your favourite chicken, cat, rabbit or any other pet you may have. **No dogs or horses, please. Small animals must be in secure cages.**

We will also have a preschooler's section and they can bring their calf, lamb or goat.

There will be coffee and cake available for sale, hamburgers, sausage sizzles, ice blocks & drinks etc. Please remember to bring cash as eftpos may not available.

There will also be a special feature from the Jack Morgan Museum.

This year the Central Calf Club at Barge Park will be held on Thursday, 2 November; where there is a great opportunity to get as many of our children to compete with their animals once again. All the work has been done, and it does take a huge amount of work to prepare an animal for Ag day. Central Day is another chance for the children to parade their animals and stockmanship. Hukerenui competes strongly on this day and we encourage all Ag Day participants to attend and compete both individually, and for Hukerenui School and getting our name on the trophy.

Another event is at Waimate North Show in November – a great opportunity to compete at another calf club and experience an authentic A&P Show. Lastly, there is the Summer Show in early December to finish off the Calf Club Season.

Please ensure that Saturday, 28 October is marked on your calendars –come along with friends and family for a wonderful community day – bring your sun umbrellas, cash (no Eftpos available) and enthusiasm. We look forward to seeing you all!

We appreciate if parents are able to come and guide the children, however, all the work is to be done by the children themselves. Judging will take place at lunchtime on Friday, 27th October.

MASTER CLASS – SATURDAY, 28TH OCTOBER

Once again we will be hosting a Masters Class for all northlanders (parents, past students and members of the community) who have unfinished business in the arena ... competitors must fit within the age range of 13 to 113 years young and be willing to show their competitive skills of presenting a fine calf, lamb or goat. The Masters Championship trophy is just waiting to have your name engraved on it.

AG DAY REGISTRATIONS

To ensure your child is registered to bring a calf, lamb or goat to Ag Day please contact Helen at the school office – (09) 4339 895 or office@hukerenui.school.nz. Calves, Lambs & goats must be born after 1st July 2017. **Registrations must be done by 1st October**, this year we will not be accepting registrations after this date. Please be fair and make sure the animal registered has been trained/cared for by the child who is entering. Only open to Hukerenui School Students.

The pet section does not require registration as it can be done on the day; however, you can phone the school office and Helen will note down the particulars.

Once your child has been registered you child will receive the Farmlands Pet booklet for recording training and rearing details.

CENTRAL CALF CLUB DAY – BARGE PARK – THURSDAY, 2ND NOVEMBER 2017

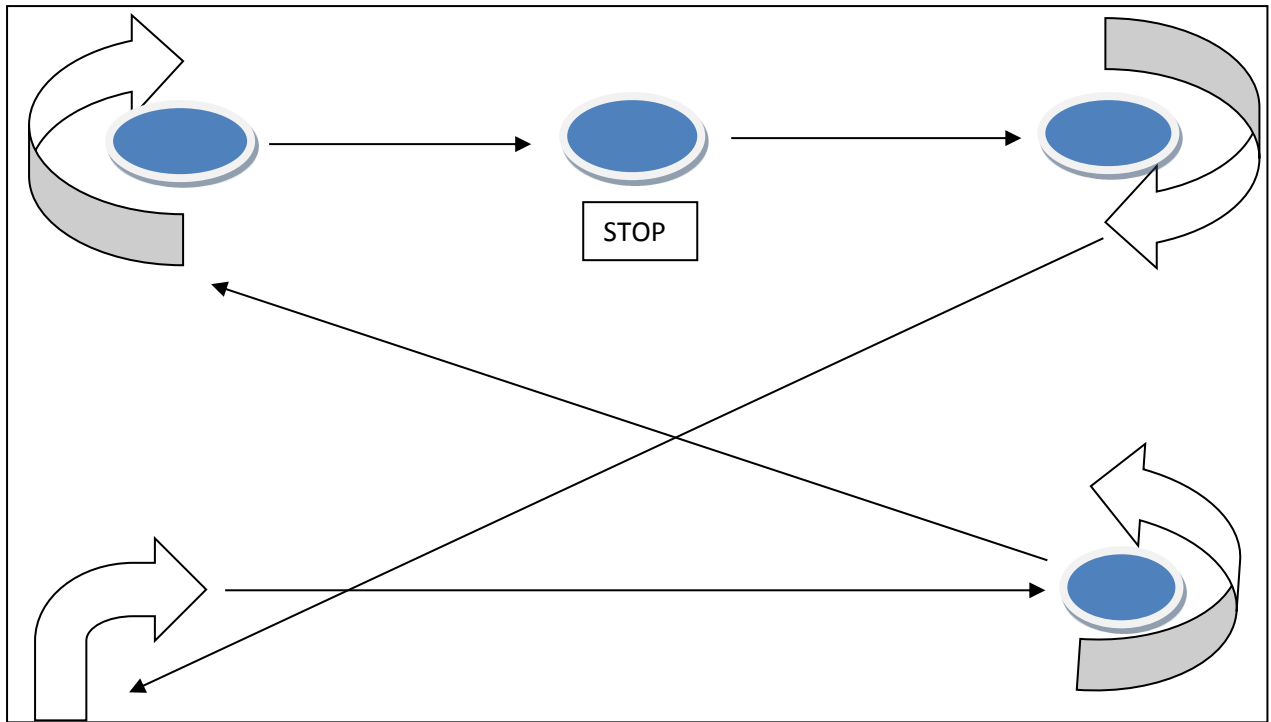
All children are also encouraged to enter the **Central Calf Club Day** being held at Barge Showground Events Centre on Thursday, 2nd November 2017. Our students attending will be given a Hukerenui Shirt to wear on the day.

Registrations are taken from 9am, with judging commencing at 10am. Animals must be born after 1st July 2017. All participants should wear enclosed footwear (no gumboots) when showing their animals. Every child will receive a certificate of participation and a ribbon. Pre-schoolers are allowed to enter but will not be eligible for prizes. They will receive a merit ribbon and certificate.
