There will be a short break while 1st place getters lead-off for Junior—Ring 2 (9yrs and under) and Senior—Ring 7 (10yrs and over) Open Leading.

Rearing in all rings in respective age groups—Junior, Intermediate and Senior.

Type in all rings in respective age groups - Junior, Intermediate and Senior

Most Obvious Pet Calf will be awarded.

Merit Ribbons will be awarded.

All 1st place-getters in Leading and Rearing or 2nd in both Leading and Rearing will then be called to lead-off for Champion of their breed.

- Light Breed - Ring 1 - All Jersey Judges
- Ayrshire - Ring 3 - Appointed Judge
- Beef - Ring 5 - Both Beef Judges
- Heavy Breed - Ring 7 - All Friesian Judges
- Dairy Crossbreed - Ring 9 - Both Crossbreed Judges

When all five breed Champions are announced they will then lead-off for "Overall Supreme Champion Calf".

During the lunch break there will be a Child Calf Judging competition which all children entering a calf, lamb or goat are eligible to enter.

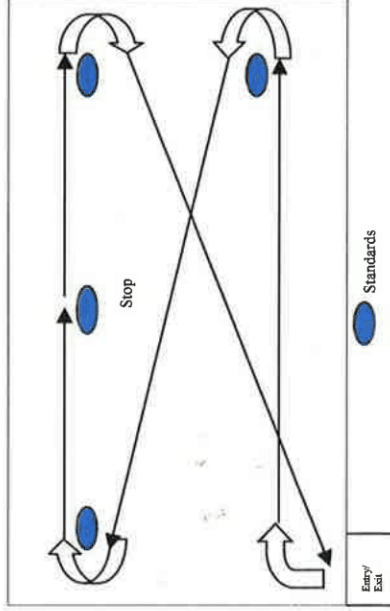

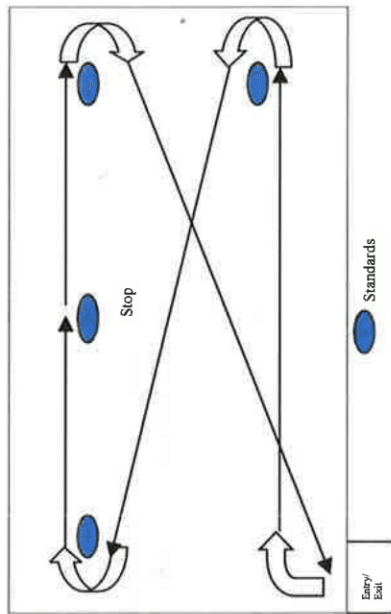
