

Hukerenui School Board of Trustees Agreement for Use of School Swimming Pool Outside of School Hours

Please Read Carefully

1. This agreement is between _____ (a parent or householder in the Hukerenui School District) authorised by the Hukerenui Board of Trustees to use the pool from mid November until the end of term one. During the school term the pool will be closed to key holders from 8.45am to 2.45pm week days.
2. One key will be issued per family for the season at the cost of \$90.00. This includes a \$15.00 bond which is refundable upon return of the key. **Use of the pool is limited to key holders and their immediate families only.** A key holders list will be displayed in the pool area and membership may be checked at random. Non key holders will be requested by any pool member to vacate the pool immediately.
3. Parents holding keys must relock the gate after their family is inside the swimming pool grounds. The gate must be locked again upon leaving the swimming pool grounds.
4. Key holders must closely supervise their accompanied children while in the pool or the pool surrounds.
5. All children 15 years and younger must be supervised by a key holder who is 16 years or older.
6. Key holders using the pool will be responsible for any damage caused by any person under their control and will see that the pool, shed and surrounds are kept in a clean and tidy condition and that the pool rules as displayed are followed. Abuse of the pool and its surrounds may be reported to the BOT by any pool member and could result in the instant loss of your key.
7. Swimming after dark will not be permitted. Groups must vacate the grounds before dark.
8. The following are not permitted anywhere on school grounds:

Dogs	Motorbikes
Golf	Smoking
Alcohol / Drugs	Skateboarding
9. Boogie boards, surfboards, jeans, bombing, running, pushing and other unsafe practices are not permitted in the pool.
10. The Board of Trustees have permitted parents the use of the pool in accordance with the terms and conditions stated here, it is understood that the board reserves the right to close the pool to the public at any time for any reason and that no refunds will be given. The board, principal and staff do not accept liability for any death, accident, loss or injury incurred through the use or misuse of the school pool. The user shall indemnify the board, principal and staff from all claims, demands, costs and proceeding that may be made against them arising out of or in connection with the use of the pool.
11. Toilets are available for key holders and their families and are located at the back of the main school block. The above rules also apply to this area. Non toilet trained pre schoolers must wear a disposable swimmers nappy when in the pool. Additional cleaning costs may be incurred by the key holder at the board's discretion for cleaning of any faecal matter in or around the pool area.

13. **If you do not return your pool key at the end of the swimming season, you will not be eligible to purchase a Hukerenui School pool key in the future.**
